he 95th Edition of the annual National Kenva Music Festivals began on Fridav August 11, 2023 with pomp and funfare at Dedan Kimathi University of Technology in Nyeri county.

This year's festival attracted more than 130,000 students from public and private schools as well as Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE), TVETs, TTC and Universities.

Students from various technical training institutes, polytechnics and universities showcased their talents during the annual event which took place under the theme Nurturing talent for Innovation and Development.

According to the Kenya Music Festival National Executive committe Chairman, Prof Fredrick Ngala, the event is the largest arts and cultural event in the academic calender and is aimed at not only creating holistic learners in and out of the classroom environment but also providing an avenue for partcipants to nurture their talents.

The festivals have been held annually since 1928, with the exception of 2020 and 2021, when the event was suspended due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Prof. Ngala noted that the country had witnessed exponential growth in the number of partcipants as well as competition categories for adjudication.

It begins at the sub-county level, then moves to county, then regional and lastly National levels. Averagely 3 million people have been engaged during this festival this vear from the sub-county level. The participation overwhelming with the representation of students from different parts of the country. where pupils draw from pre-primary all the way to university.

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PWPER RECOMMENDATIONS ON SEPU'S NEW MANDATE

- The Prof. Munavu led Presidential Working Party on Education Reforms recommended some of the following to be SEPU's new mandate;

1. Restructure of SEPU to School Learning and Instructional Materials Centre (SLIMC) to coordinate the procurement and distribution of MoE approved textbooks and other learning resources.

2. Train publishers and digital content creators on the development of quality content for both regular and SNE learners.

3. SLIMC to procure for digital resources hosted in Kenya Education Cloud (KEC).

4. Formulate guidelines on textbooks and curriculum support materials to ensure the best two evaluated textbooks by KICD are supplied to each school.

The center shall be a semi-autonomous governement agency within the State Department Basic Education with the following membership: State Department for Basic Education, Kenya Institute of Curriculum Development, Kenya National Examination Council, Kenya Teacher Training College, National Treasury and Private Schools Association.

This is the transformation from SEPU into School Learning and Instructional Material Centre (SLIMC).
